Dear Parents,

This is to inform you that from academic year 2022-23 CBSE has restored Board Examination for class X and has advised the Schools to follow a similar pattern for class - IX.

Accordingly a change in the system of Examination has been proposed and this is to make you aware of the changes so that you can prepare your ward accordingly.

- 1. An academic year has been divided into 2 terms Term I & Term-II.
- 2. Each term will have 2 cycle of unit tests. One cycle of unit tests will be of 40 marks and the second one will be of 80 marks.
- 3. It is mandatory for a student to appear in all the unit tests. A student would have to obtain at least 33% marks in internal assessments (DA & Projects) to be eligible to qualify the examination.
- 4. The maximum marks of mid term & final term exams will be 80 marks.
- 5. The final exam will cover the whole syllabus, i.e. from UT-1 to the last exam UT-4. Thus, each subsequent unit test / exam will have cumulative syllabus.
- 6. Parents are requested to note that your ward will have to cover all the syllabus done till the last date of any exam. For example UT 2 will also cover the syllabus of UT-1. Half yearly syllabus will cover UT 1 & 2. Third UT will cover the chapters taught for UT 1 2 and Half Yearly Exam. Likewise UT-4 will cover UT-1, 2 and 3 and Half Yearly Exam.
- 7. Classes VI -IX Final Examinations will be held in the School. Class-X Final Board Examination will be held by CBSE.
- 8. Marks and Grades will be awarded for individual subjects. Co Scholastic activities and Discipline will be graded on a scale of A - E.

8. In final examination the aggregate percentage will be calculated as follows: -

- 10. Parents please note that child will be required to be regular in attendance, assignments, projects, assessments & tests etc. So, we expect your cooperation in your child's regularity and continuous good performance throughout the year.

These values will have a bearing on the student's result and for his/her promotion.
