R. No. 31 onwards Make Continents and Oceans on the World Physical Map.

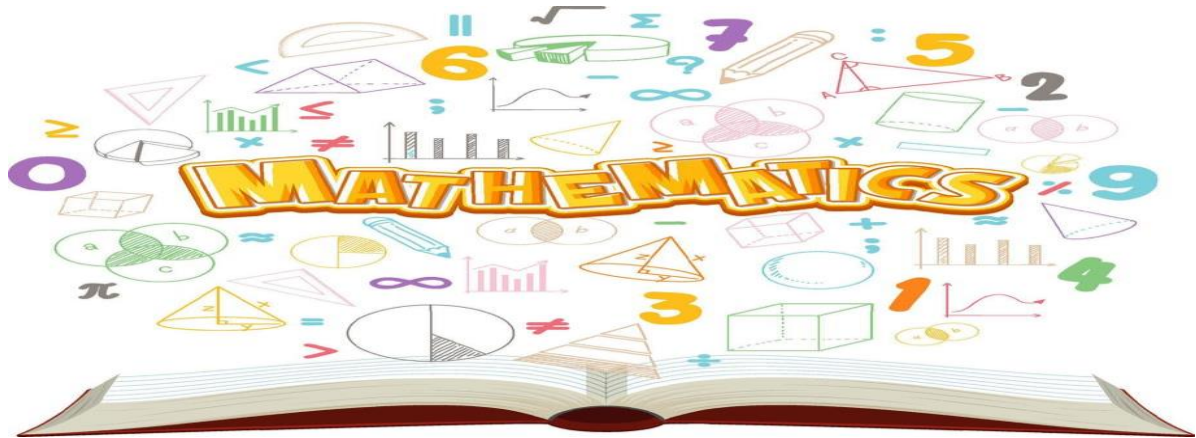
(Project to be done on cardboard and file is compulsory.)
