With no refusal and no fighting.*

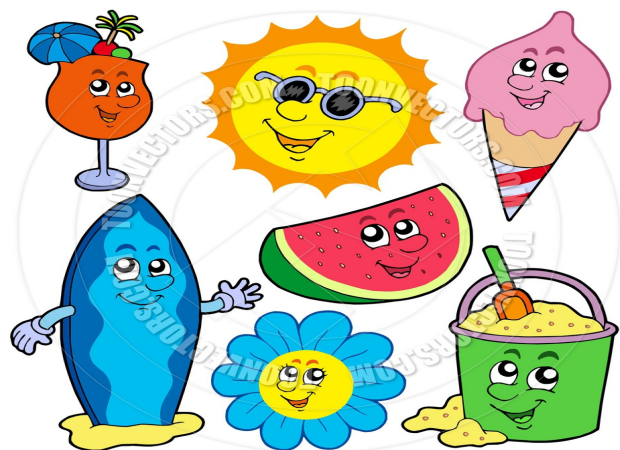
Dear Parents,

Maths -

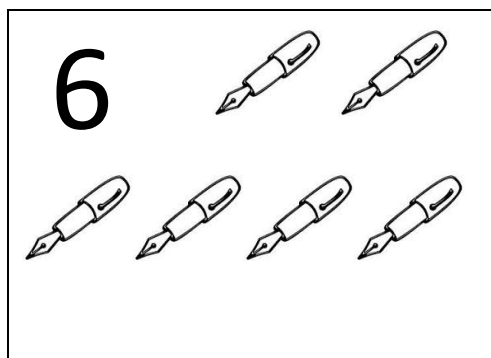
1. Revise (do written practice) all the work done in the class.

Art and Craft work -

4. Make a chart on the topic (given in the school diary) on the pastel sheet of any colour. The size of the chart should be 20 x 20 inches.

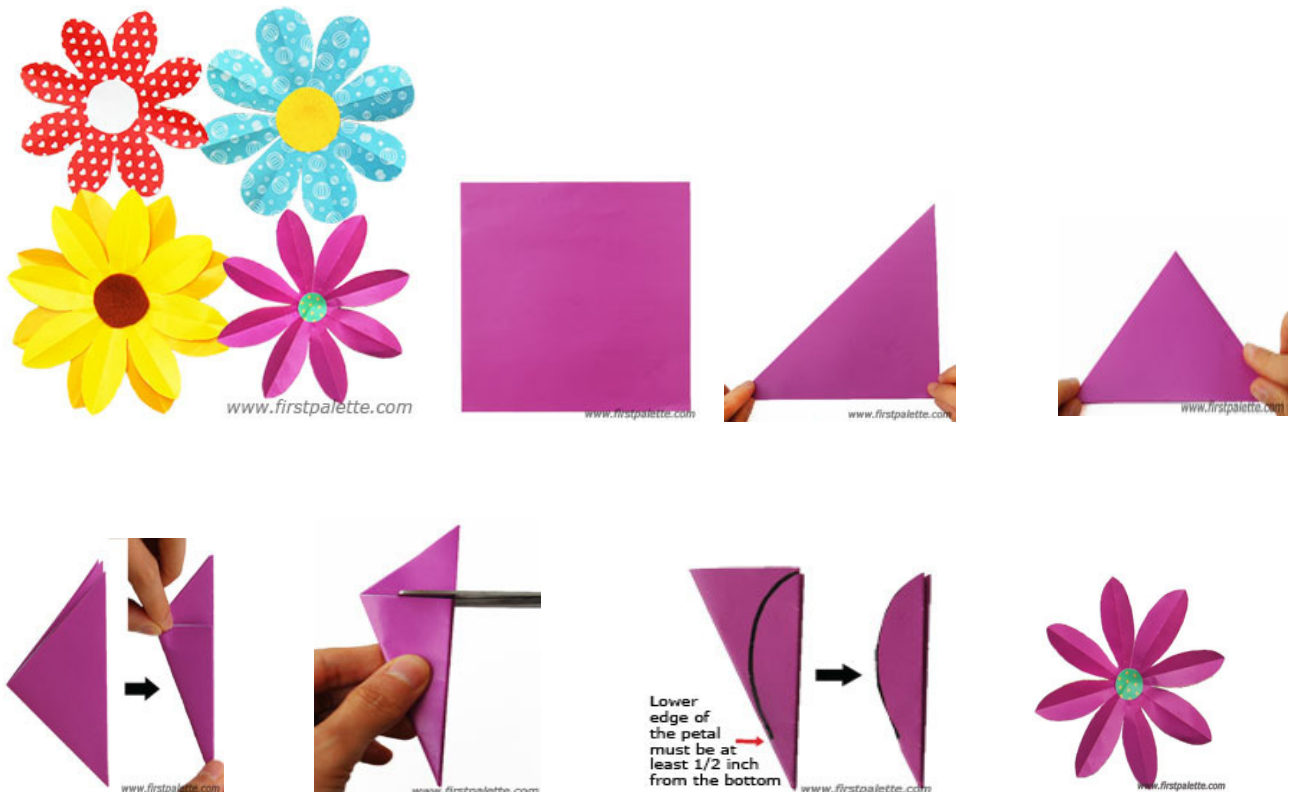
Part - 2

Art & Craft

Folding paper flowers

Materials required - Paper ,Scissors ,Glue , A-4 size pastel sheet with glitter tape border.

Steps – 1. Take one origami sheet. 2. Fold the sheet diagonally in the middle to come up with a triangle. 3. Fold the resulting triangle once again to get a smaller triangle. 4. Trim off the extra paper above triangle. 5. Draw half-a-petal starting from the top corner of the triangle's vertical side and ending about a half-inch from the bottom of the triangle's long side. 6. Cut along the outline. 7. Gently open up the paper to reveal an eight-petaled flower. 8. Cut out a circle from paper/ felt / craft foam/ fabric etc. 9. Glue it at the center of the flower. 10. Make 8 – 10 flowers with different coloured paper and arrange (paste) beautifully on the A-4 size pastel sheet. 11. Your folding paper flowers bouquet is ready.



Yellow Handprint Sun

Materials Required- Compass or any object to make a circle , Construction paper ,Yellow poster / water colour , Gold glitter , Crayons , Scotch tape

Steps – 1. Draw and cut a circle on white construction paper. 2. Paint the circle with yellow poster paint. 3. Sprinkle gold glitter while the paint is still wet. Set the circle aside to dry. 4. Paint your palm with yellow paint. 5. Press your painted hand onto orange construction paper. 6. Repeat Steps 4 and 5 until you make about 5 to 6 yellow hand prints. Let the paint dry for several minutes. 7. Cut around all the hand prints. 8. Tape the hand prints around the back of the painted circle to make the sun's rays. 9. In the last draw a face on your sun to have a nice appearance.
