7. Encourage your child to do the activities himself / herself and appoint a specific time to do homework everyday.

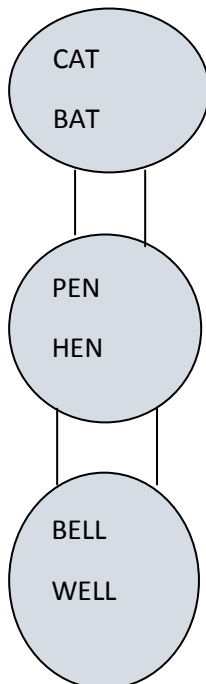

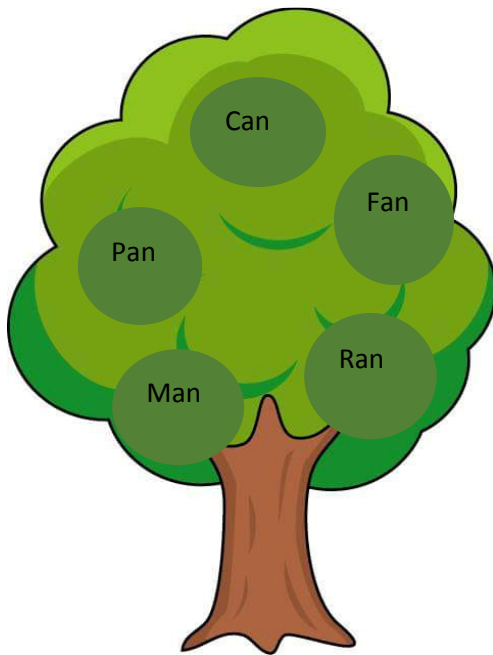
