Mathematics Holiday's Home Work

3. My Birthday

Instructions:

Take an A4 Size sheet. Write your date of birth in DDMMYY format. Rearrange the digits to form a greatest and smallest 6-digit number out of it.

4. Numbers Around Me

Instructions:

Look for 5 and 6 digit numbers around you (in newspapers, bills, books) and paste their cut outs on A4 size sheet. Arrange the numbers in ascending and descending order.

5. Andaman and Nicobar Island

Instructions:

Take an A4 size sheet and draw a colourful scenery of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Draw 5 coconut trees in the picture. If each tree has 4 coconuts, find the total number of coconuts. Solve the question by writing the statement.

6. Division Ferris Wheel

Instructions:

Take an A4 Size sheet and draw a big colourful Ferris wheel with cabins. In each

cabin, write one division property with an example. Colour the wheel brightly and decorate the background like funfair.

7. Cupcakes magic

Instructions:

Draw 4 cupcakes on A4 size sheet. Write different 6- digit numbers on each cupcake wrapper. Write each number in words as per International Number System.

8. Abacus: Number Challenge

Instructions:

Take an A4 size sheet and draw an abacus with 6 rods labelled Hundred Thousand, Ten Thousand, Thousand, Hundreds, Tens, and Ones. Show beads to represent any 6-digit number. Write the number neatly below the abacus. Then write the number name in words and its expanded form. Choose any one digit from the number and find its place value and face value. Also find their sum and difference.
