Dear Parents,

Summer vacation gives us a beautiful chance to spend meaningful time with our children and help them develop good habits and values that stay with them for life. Here are a few simple ways to nurture good manners and positive behaviour in your child:

- 1. Encourage your child to wait patiently for their turn to speak and avoid interrupting others. Also, give them your full attention when they speak. Children learn respect by watching adults.**
- 2. Involve your child in setting the dining table correctly with plates, spoons, forks, napkins, and glasses. Teach them how to use table manners properly.**
- 3. Remind them about basic table etiquette such as keeping the napkin on the lap, not placing elbows on the table, and chewing food with their mouth closed.**
- 4. Make “thank you” a habit. Children learn polite words by hearing them from their parents regularly.**
- 5. Use the word “please” while speaking to your child. Your polite behaviour teaches them to speak kindly with others.**
- 6. Teach your child to ask permission before taking or borrowing anything and to return it properly afterwards.**
- 7. Try to remain calm while talking to your child. Gentle communication helps build trust and respect.**
- 8. Encourage your child to accept compliments politely by saying “thank you.”**

Most importantly, children follow what they see at home, so always lead by example.
